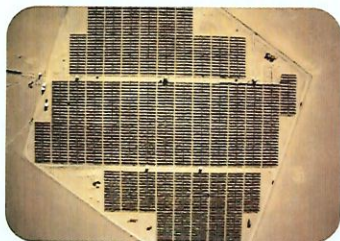


Health, Safety, Environment and Security Policy

We **comply with the legal requirements** applicable in the sector, being much more demanding with this compliance if necessary. Responsibility for these principles involves **C-Suite, the whole workforce and contractors** through the integration and proactive application of the integrated management system. In order to fulfill these commitments, X-ELIO has established an **integrated management system** for the **environment, occupational health, safety and welfare** in accordance with the ISO 14001:2015 and ISO 45001:2018 standards and the healthy organization management system.



Health and Safety

X-ELIO's ultimate objective is to achieve **zero high risk incidents and zero lost days** due to workplace injuries.

Health and safety commitments are assumed and promoted through the following instruments:

- C-Suite **engagement and leadership** in health and safety management.
- **Responsibility and rights** of the entire workforce to contribute to the **safe performance** of their work.
- Focussing efforts on the **elimination of all risks** that could lead to any type of incident for the **employees, contractors, visitors, third parties and the communities** that could be affected by our activity.
- Clearly defined **organizational structure and responsibilities**.
- Establishment of clear, measurable, challenging and auditable **objectives**.
- **Ongoing training, education and coaching** to promote safe behaviors and raise awareness of the impact of our work on the safety of people, processes and facilities.
- Planning for emergency situations by establishing appropriate **response plans**.

This policy is customized for our organization and it is communicated to personnel and understood by them as a commitment of their participation and as a commitment with Quality Management, Environment, Occupational Health and Safety of employees and labor welfare. - **Defining the roles and responsibilities** in terms of security for all workforce that makes up its organizational and operational structure.
- Promoting the **participation of managers and employees** relating to the diverse business areas of the organization.
- Focusing on the fundamental elements of the **preparedness, prevention, detection, response, and recovery**.
